



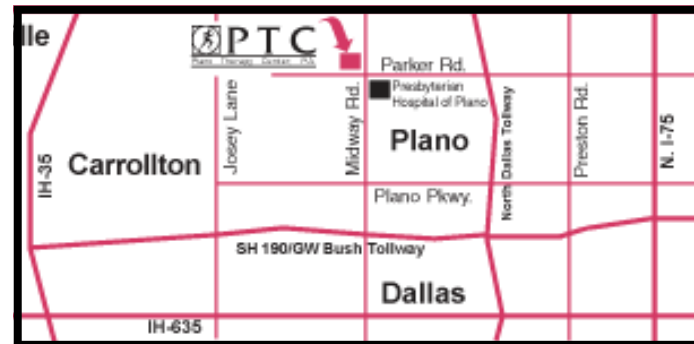
What is the purpose of an F-Scan®?

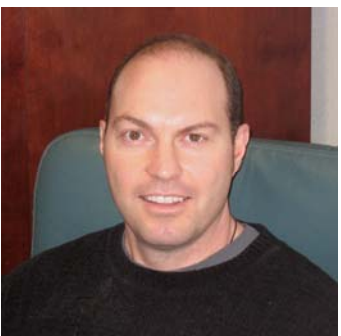

Dr. Moore is able to provide advanced computerized gait analysis through the use of the F-Scan machine, which measures a patient's gait pattern through pressurized foot sensors. Dr. Moore utilizes this technology to analyze runner performance, as well as monitor disorders of the foot.



What to Wear:

- ◆ Comfortable/loose fitting clothes
- ◆ Athletic/walking shoes
- ◆ Ankle socks

What to Expect:

- ◆ Sensors will be placed in patient's shoes
- ◆ Patients will be asked to run or walk on the treadmill
- ◆ Doctor will observe patient's gait on computer in real time
- ◆ Appointment will take approximately 60 minutes to complete

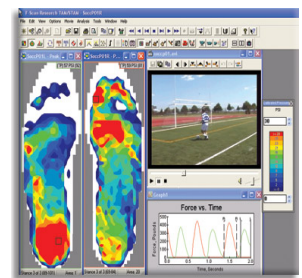
